Title : Finding Our Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria And The Ends Of The Earth

1. Challenges of Modern Day Church

- Too many programmes, too few volunteers and leaders,
- Leaders are not committed, not clear of direction and members are not growing spiritually
- Leaders are not united and without a clear vision and mission

2. Critical Ways Modern-Day Church can do Missions

- By doing what Submissive Son did (Matthew 4:19-20; 28:18-20)
Mission of Submissive Son- **Making Disciples** (Mt 4:19-20; Matthew 28:18-20)
- By doing what the Spirit wanted the Church to do (Acts 1:8)

3. Correct places where Modern Day Church must do Missions

- Jerusalem (Place called Home)
- Judea (Places close by)
- Samaria (Places with different language and customs)
- Ends of the earth (Places where Christ is least known)

4. Church needs to send the right people to do Missions (Acts 13:1-3)

- **Pioneers** where Christ is not known
- **Parents** where Gospel is preached/people are saved
- **Producers** of Missional Churches where Disciples are growing spiritually
- **Partners** who facilitate locals to Participate in World Mission
