DOROTHY KOH

That I May Know Him, the One Who is For Me



Years ago, when I pondered on what I wanted to do with my life, the only thing which came to mind was that I wanted to study theology. Theology, as the study of God, can never be boring, because God is infinitely interesting. For me, doing theology is more than just an academic exercise. It is one way I can worship God and serve Him.

For my Master of Theology (MTh) thesis, I explored an area of theology known as theological anthropology, which is the study of the human person from a theological perspective. In particular, I wanted to determine a clear theological reason for human sexuality: why God created us as male and female beings. For this purpose, I looked into the

writings of Karl Barth, who roots the reason for human sexuality in the concept of the *imago Dei*, or image of God. Barth could arguably be the first influential Protestant theologian of the 20th century to posit the image of God as being the relationship between man and woman.

I am blessed to have the support of my husband (Matthias) and PSPC for my MTh studies. I am grateful for the privilege of working under Rev Dr Edmund Fong, who supervised me and combed through my drafts, giving me valuable feedback. I am also thankful for the new friends I have made on this journey. Throughout this time, I experienced God's providence as He directed me to relevant resources, enabled me to understand the material, and guided my thoughts as I wrote what I hoped would bless His church.

While love always points to the truth of God's Word, true love is demonstrated in this: while we were still sinners, God gave His Son for us (Rom 5:8). To be the One for us. In all our journeys, let us seek to know Him, as we share in His sufferings, becoming like Him in His death, that we may share in His resurrection life (Phil 3:10-11). In reconciling God's design with the fallenness of this world, we can hold on to His promise of a coming time when He will wipe away every tear from our eyes and make all things new (Rev 21:4-5).
