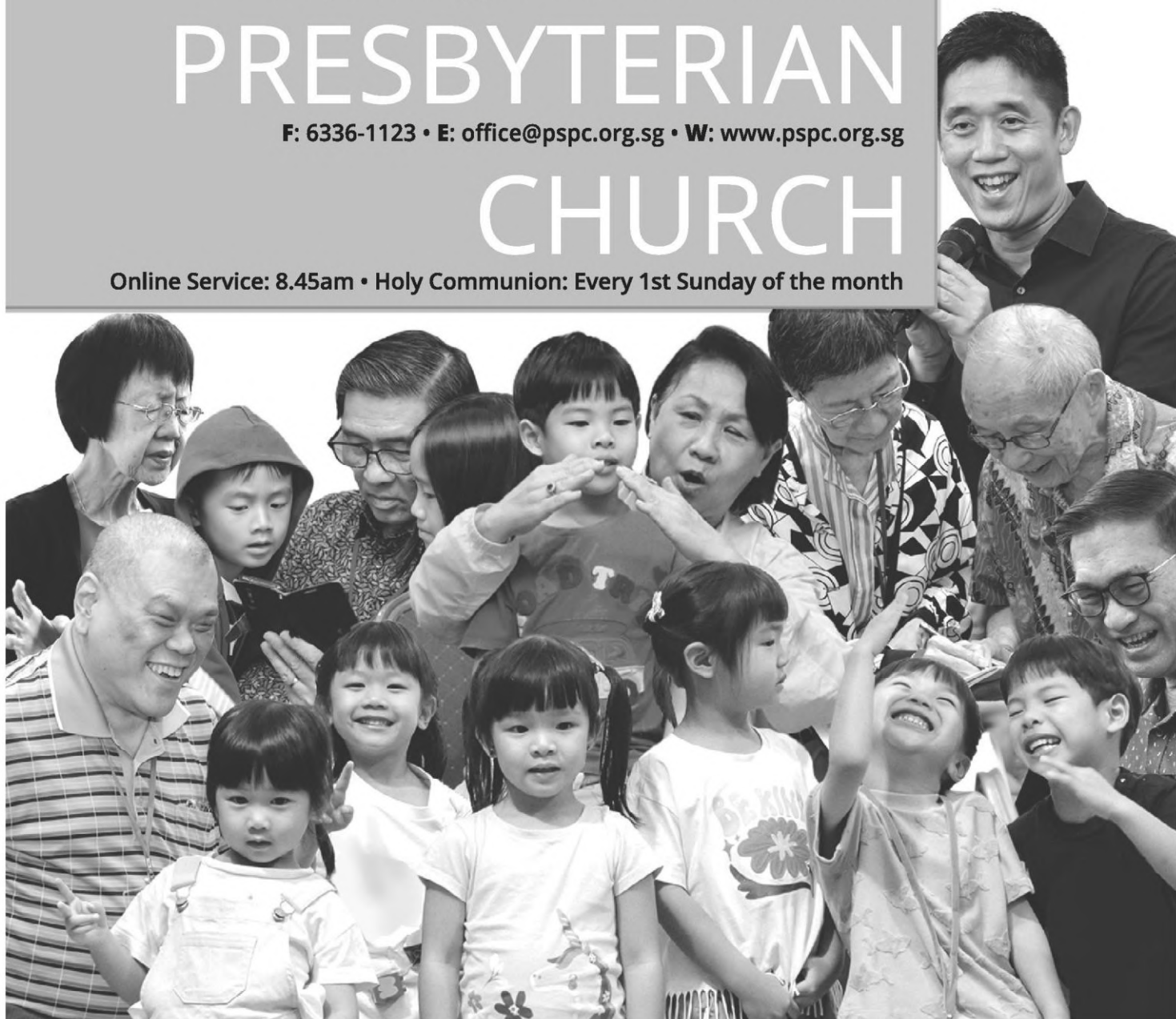

4. **Angel Tree Project 2026**

The Angel Tree Project is an initiative by Prison Fellowship Singapore (PFS), aiming to encourage reconciliation between the incarcerated and their families, through the delivery of letters written by inmates to their families, along with a supermarket gift card.

This year, PSPC has pledged to deliver up to 50 letters and vouchers and is seeking **25 teams** of volunteers to assist with this delivery. Home visitation will take place from the end of November to Christmas Day 2026. 5. **PSPC Thailand Short-Term Mission Trips**

The Northern Thailand short-term mission team has been blessed this year with 33 members. Two teams will be sent in December, one to Chiang Rai and one to Chiang Mai.

The Chiang Rai team will partner closely with Baan Klang Baptist Church to bring the gospel to various hill tribes. The Chiang Mai team will support Wycliffe in outreach efforts to both the Chiang Mai community and the East Lawa people.

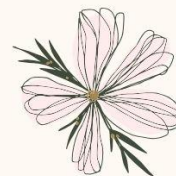
